## **Brewery Review**

Hairy Cow Brewing Companyhttps://hairycowbrewing.com/450 E Blackhawk Dr, Byron, IL

I recently attended a quilt show in Oregon, Illinois and hopped over to Byron for lunch at **Hairy Cow Brewing**. It was surprising to find such a large brewpub in a town of only about 3600 people. The brewery, which opened in 2016, sits on the banks of the Rock River. They have a spacious tap room/dining room and two outdoor patios (one covered and one open) that overlook the river. For



food, they specialize in pizza made in a large Italian pizza oven (which my chef daughter was coveting) and house-made cheesecake. The two pizzas we tried were delicious! Of the fourteen beers on the tap list, only two were IPAs!

**Ogle Oats** – **Oatmeal Stout**. Dark and creamy with a light, well-balanced sweetness

**Dos Dookies – Milk Stout**. Full bodied and roasty with a somewhat burnt, harsh edge.

**Sour Todd – Fruited Sour**. A murky-looking sour with cherries & berries. Quite tart, but tasty.

**Kyloe Coconut Porter** – Porter with a very well-balanced addition of coconut, vanilla bean, and cacao. Sweet but with a good hop balance.

**Sláinte Mhath – RIS.** Rich, sweet, and luscious. A great sipping beer to accompany your cheesecake!
